3. Use alcohol gel on your hands when you enter the building.

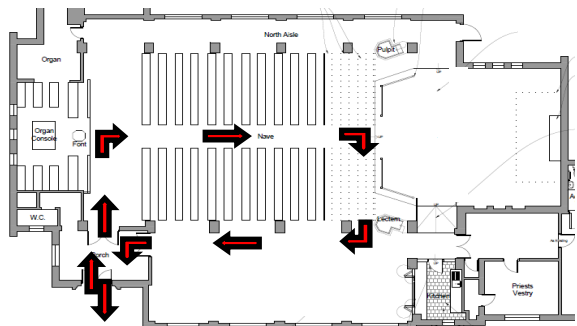
4. Stay at least 2m apart from anyone who is not in your own household or bubble. This is why some pews are not in use.

These will be kept covered until they are distributed. Tina will use alcohol gel and drop the wafers onto your palm to avoid physical contact.

Do Not Fear

Last year there were over 600,000 ‘excess deaths.’ That means 600,000 more people have died than usually expected. About a quarter were due to Covid. The rest were indirect consequences of the pandemic. That’s almost one in every hundred people.

No wonder so many people have become more frightened and anxious. Some worry about the threat of new variants of Covid-19. For others, it’s the consequence of lockdowns and social isolation. People who found social contact exhausting have enjoyed our time of seclusion. The thought of visiting a busy shopping centre or market can be nerve-racking.

Google tells me that the words ‘fear not,’ or something similar, appear in the Bible 365 times. That’s one reminder from God not to worry for every day of the year. Here’s a sample:

“So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.” Isaiah 41:10

“When I am afraid, I put my trust in you.” ~Psalm 56:3

“Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.” Philippians 4:6-7

“Peace is what I leave with you; it is my own peace that I give you. I do not give it as the world does. Do not be worried and upset; do not be afraid.” John 14:27

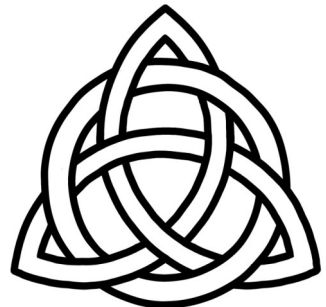

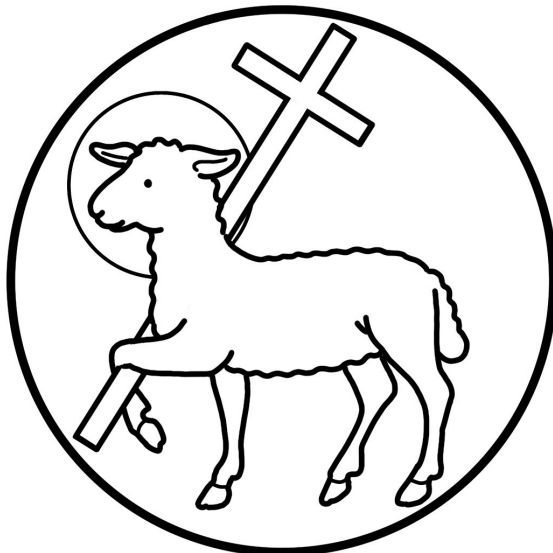
GIVING ENVELOPES

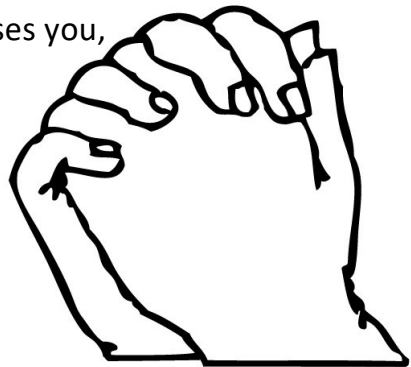

Thy Kingdom Come is a global prayer movement that invites Christians around the world to pray from Ascension to Pentecost for more people to come to know Jesus.

Since its start in May 2016 God has grown Thy Kingdom Come from a dream of possibility into a movement. Christians from 172 countries have taken part in praying 'Come Holy Spirit', so that friends and family, neighbours and colleagues might come to faith in Jesus Christ.

This praying together has been across our diversity and differences as every person, household and church are encouraged to pray in their own way

During the 11 days of Thy Kingdom Come, it is hoped that everyone who takes part will:

- Deepen their own relationship with Jesus Christ

- Pray for 5 friends or family to come to faith in Jesus
- Pray for the empowerment of the Holy Spirit that we would be effective in our witness

After the very first Ascension Day the disciples gathered with Mary, constantly devoting themselves to prayer while they waited for the outpouring of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. Like them, our reliance on the gift of the Holy Spirit is total – on our own we can do nothing.

Through the centuries Christians have gathered at that time to pray for the coming of the Holy Spirit. 'Thy Kingdom Come' picks up this tradition. Over the years more and more worshipping communities have dedicated the days between Ascension and Pentecost to pray 'Come Holy Spirit'.

We are praying that the Spirit will inspire and equip us to share the Good News of Jesus Christ with

our friends and families, our communities and networks. It has been amazing how many varied ways there have been in which people from every tradition have taken up this challenge. The effects have been remarkable.

It is our prayer that those who have not yet heard the Good News of Jesus Christ and his love for the world will hear it for themselves, and respond and follow Him. Specifically, we again invite each and every Christian across the globe to pray that God's Spirit might work in the lives of 5 friends who have not responded with their 'Yes' to God's call.

Almighty God, your ascended son has sent us into the world to preach the good news of your kingdom: inspire us with your Spirit and fill our hearts with the fire of your love, that all who hear your word may be drawn to you, through Jesus Christ our Lord Amen.

How to pray

1. Prayerfully choose five people to pray for, and pray during these 11 days that they would know the transforming love of Christ.
2. Set a time each day when you will take a moment of prayer. You only need about 10 minutes.
3. Set a reminder on your phone, a note on your fridge or somewhere visible to prompt you to pray each day

I am a mum, wife, social worker, and a Church of England Reader. I am married to Mark and we have 2 children who are at University.

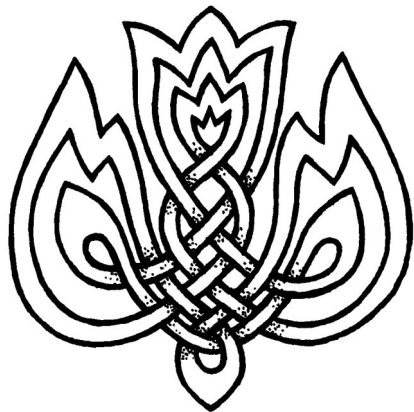

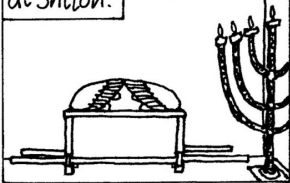
Bible Bite

The next day it was over again and its head and hands had broken off.



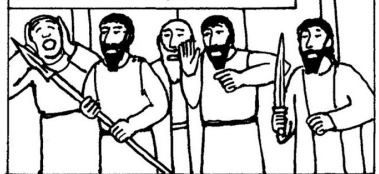
Then the people became covered in sores.

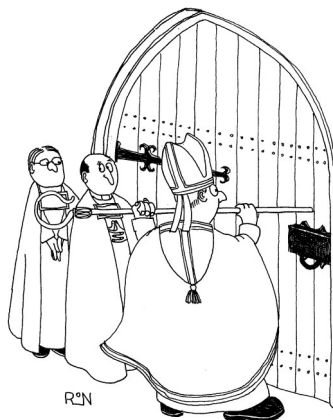
